

Alcohol Use Policy

Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited on Hiawatha Public Library property except in accordance with the provisions of this policy.

Alcoholic beverages are sometimes served in conjunction with special events held at the library. Alcoholic beverages will be served in compliance with state and local laws.

This policy clarifies how and under what circumstances alcohol may be served.

- 1. Wine and beer may be served at special events hosted by the Hiawatha Public Library or the Friends of the Hiawatha Public Library.
- 2. With prior approval from the library director, wine and beer may be served at special events hosted by other entities of the City of Hiawatha government.
- 3. Alcohol use is restricted to the Glenn Schminke and the Forrest Kramer Community Rooms.
- 4. Alcohol is not permitted at youth activities or public hearings, nor may alcohol be served to minors.
